The Steele County Commission meeting was called to order at 8:16 am. Present were Commissioners Perry Brown, Brandon Krueger, Richard Strand, Brandon Oxtan and Chris Grandalen. Also present, Auditor Jana Flaten.

Commissioner Strand made a motion to approve the August minutes, second by Commissioner Oxtan. No further discussion, all members voted aye. Motion carried.

Discussion on the 2025 budget was had- Commissioner Strand made a motion to approve the 2025 budget. Commissioner Krueger seconded the motion. No further discussion, all members voted aye. Motion carried.

Public Health Administrator Zamora gave an update – Flu clinics are set up for here at the courthouse, Hope and Sharon. Footcare will be added to the home health care. Ashton Rose (Public Health Nurse) will be doing these along with her other tasks when she is there. Zamora is working on bills and insurance and hopes to have that done soon.

Commissioner Strand made a motion to approve the building permits presented by Tax Director Olson, seconded by Commissioner Oxtan. No further discussion, all members voted aye. Motion carried.

Auditor Flaten gave an update on the delinquent taxes.

Interstate Engineering gave an update that the CO Road 18 project will start Thursday. The railroad will be getting done also but it is an exclusion. Reed talked with the elevator and will continue to work with them while the road work is getting done.

Hugo Township engineering contract was presented. This job is reimbursed by the state and the county will be sending it in on behalf of the township. Commissioner Strand made a motion to Approve the contract, Seconded by Commissioner Krueger. No further discussion, all members voted aye. Motion carried.

Commissioner Strand made a motion to approve the pay request for RJ Zavoral, seconded by Commissioner Oxtan. No further discussion, all members voted aye. Motion carried.

Commissioner Strand made a motion to approve the bills, second by Commissioner Oxtan. No further discussion, all members voted aye. Motion carried.
