Tyler Flaten with NorthStar Electric met with the commission to discuss the courthouse generator. Flaten stated that the lead time on the generator is 24 weeks.


The 2022 budgets were reviewed at length by the board. The commission discussed inquiring on the cost of a salary survey for the county employees.
