The Steele County Park Board meeting was called to order at 8:17 am. Present were Chairman Matt Roller, board members Richard C. Strand, Ted Johnson, Brandon Krueger, Brian Tuite and Russell Walcker.

A motion was made by Tuite, seconded by Krueger to approve the minutes as presented. All members voted yes. Motion carried.

Dickson was not present to provide an update on Golden Lake Acres. They are open Friday and Saturday currently. Auditor Wigen inquired about any maintenance that needs to be completed before the end of year, along with any outstanding bills to be presented for approval and reimbursement. Roller will contact Dickson to gather them for the next meeting.

Roller discussed the park board mower and potential for trading it in, as it has 500 hours and starting to have trouble. The current mower is four years old. Quotes and prices will be gathered before spring.

Issues with bathrooms at North Golden Lake were brought forth. The option of cameras and signage to detour it from happening was discussed.

There was no update on the emergency shelters for the lake. The estimated cost to the county is \$25,000.

A motion was made by Strand, seconded by Walcker to adjourn the meeting. All members voted yes. Motion carried.
