The Steele County Park Board meeting was called to order at 8:05am. Present was Chairman Matt Roller, board members Brandon Krueger, Brian Tuite, Russell Walcker, Richard C. Strand, and Ted Johnson.


A motion was made by Walcker, seconded by Tuite to approve the April 2021 minutes as presented. All members voted yes. Motion carried.

Dickson provided an update that the bathrooms have been moved and remodeled within the store, and installed LED lights in convenience area, kitchen, and bathrooms. Emergency lights were also installed in the kitchen, dining area and both bathrooms. Dickson had Ness Plumbing install shut off valves in the kitchen and bathrooms and moved the thermostat and some duct work in the kitchen. Verwest installed new coolers and repaired wiring for the MLGC cut while boring. Verwest also installed shatter proof caging for the lights in the outdoor bathrooms. Black dirt was brought into level lots on the north campground and fill in the water lines that have sunk in the south part of the campground. Two loads of gravel were brought to an area for storage shed. A six-yard dumpster was purchased for the store. Dickson will fix the shingles; however, the skirting still needs to be repaired. UV lights were installed in the ducts to help purify the air. A lot of repairs are still needed; roof may need to be replaced in the next couple years.

Lyndon Pease, Moore Engineering, informed Roller that one source of funding was approved and two more in the works and hopeful. Water quality testing is currently being done.

Bathroom partitions are not installed yet. Walcker suggested getting someone else to do these repair projects to assure they are completed.

A motion was made by Strand, seconded by Krueger to adjourn the meeting at 8:20 am. Meeting adjourned.
